

Naturism in Southern Europe



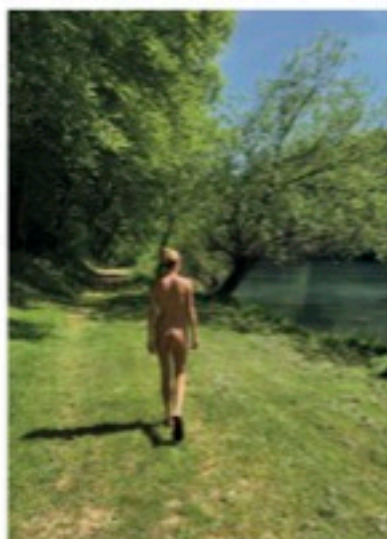
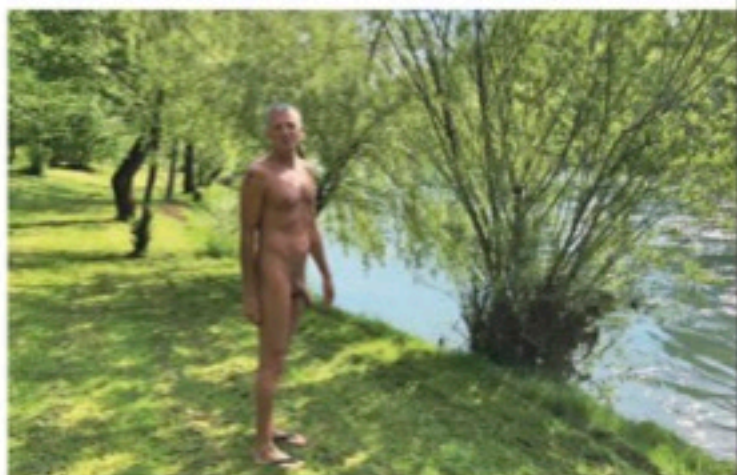

Slovenia for us is a 15 minute drive but to get to our favourite campsite in the south of the country is just under 2.5 hours in the camper. Mali Raj is just the perfect Naturist campsite for us as it's deep in the Slovenian countryside with lots of hiking and biking opportunities. It's right on the Krka river where you can paddle board, kayak or just take a refreshing dip on a hot day. It's small, intimate, perfectly clean, very green and, as there is no entertainment or swimming pool, it's always quiet and relaxing. Adding to all this its sublime beauty, and the wonderful Naturist owners, leads to the most amazing place to be and relax in nature's real paradise. And as a bonus there are natural hot springs in the area, tennis courts a few minutes away and, if the weather is not co-operating, there is a full Naturist Spa within walking distance with a host of naked saunas and pools.

We often go to large Naturist campsites all over Europe and they have their own attraction but the surrounding countryside of Mali Raj has so much to offer the outdoor enthusiast and the campsite has so much to offer the spiritual yogi. I love the sports but being able to completely switch off is something that people are just not able to do any more and for Leela it's paradise to do yoga next to the river and paint all day in these incredible surroundings.
